This beautiful Elizabethan manor house has delighted visitors for centuries. Visiting in the 19th century, Charlotte Bronte featured it as 'Fieldhead'. Built in 1583, the hall is now set out as it would have been in the 1690s, when it was the home of the Batt family. Set in a beautiful countryside park, where you can stroll around the delightful period garden or check out the inhabitants of the wildlife garden.

The rally will be held on grass in front of the Hall itself, very near the Hall's visitors centre courtyard, toilets & close to the Hall's own cafe. As usual a donation to a local charity will be made from any rally 'surplus'.

1. The rally will be held from 10.00am to 4.00pm on Sunday 4th June 2017. Organizers will be on site from 9.00am. No vehicles onsite before 9.00am please, but all vehicles must be on site by 10.00am
2. The rally site will be clearly sign-posted from Dewsbury Road, which is the main vehicle entrance to the Hall.
3. Entrants will be expected to follow ALL instructions from the rally marshals regarding driving, parking & displaying of vehicles. Whilst on the rally field, please keep your dog on a lead at all times & supervise any children you bring.
4. Closing date for entry is 26th May 2017, late entries & on the day entries are welcome, but cannot be guaranteed an entry into the rally programme or entry to the rally field.
5. Neither the Organizers, The Rover Sports Register, The Yorkshire Rover Club, nor Kirklees Council will be held responsible for any damage to vehicles or persons attending the rally.
6. All vehicles displayed must be covered by a valid motor insurance policy, covering at least third party risks.
